Welcome to the SSKA Annual Summer Camp 2023! I hope you enjoy both your training and your stay at the Bournemouth Central Premier Inn, 18 Westover Road, Bournemouth BH1 2BY.

SATURDAY 12th AUGUST

Arrive early to get a space in the Central Car Park, Upper Hinton Road, BH1 2HH. (300 spaces).

You can only pay with a card and it's £5.80p for 24 hours. Please check the ticket to see that it's valid as I have been told that sometimes it does not register. It is a 10 minute walk to the hotel. There are stairs at the rear of the car park which take you down to the road. Turn left as the bottom of the stairs and walk to the end of the road, then turn right and the Premier Inn is on the right.
